

Parent/Educator Guide

Welcome to the Parent and Educator Guide! This guide will help you go through the site and guide your child through the lessons and activities in an engaging, informative, and meaningful way! Follow these steps to get the most out of each topic and also to get some amazing tips that will make the experience all that much better.

Step 1: Start with the Short Descriptions

- **How to Use:** Each page starts with a short and simple description of the lesson/topic. The goal with this is to introduce the subject briefly so your child can understand what we are learning and what to expect.
 - **Tip:** Read the description out loud or paraphrase it in order to make it more relatable to them. You can also use this time to get them to read along with you and to get them to tell you what they already know about the topic.
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Step 2: Read Social Stories Together

- **How to Use:** This story section is here to give participants a way to understand the overarching lesson/theme of the topic. Sometimes, it can be a theme, and sometimes, it can be a lesson, so another helpful strategy could be to ask them if they can spot the theme or lesson after reading the story.
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Step 3: Follow the Step-by-Step Guide

- **How to Use:** The step-by-step guide is here to help break down rituals and practices into more feasible actions. This helps make the topic more understandable and graspable for your child.
 - **Tip:** To make the most out of this section, you can let your child take on one of these steps and encourage them as they go. Make sure to help them and ensure that you set a goal that they can reach.
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Step 4: Download Printable Worksheets

- **How to Use:** Each topic has a downloadable worksheet that your child can enjoy. This can be a game, a coloring activity, or a visual sheet.

- **Tip:** In order to make the most out of these, print them and have your child have some fun completing the worksheet. This can raise their enjoyment during this learning process! Also, ensure to discuss the main topics in the sheet to help reinforce themes, etc.
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Step 5: Listen to the Blessings

- **How to Use:** Each lesson/topic has relevant and related blessings in both Hebrew and English. Your child can listen to the blessing while following along with the text.
 - **Tip:** In order to get the most out of this section, encourage your child to try their best to say the blessing a couple of times and repeat after the audio.
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Step 6: Engage with the Quiz

- **How to Use:** Lastly, have your child complete the quiz or game to see how much they have learned and also to reinforce some of the main topics. Make sure to celebrate once they finish!
 - **Tip:** The biggest tip for this section is to make it fun! This “quiz” shouldn't feel like it for a grade; it should feel like a chance for them to show off their new knowledge to you! Also, remember that if they get stuck, be sure to help them and reinforce their confidence with the topic.
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
